

Loved Object Exchange

“Shared Love”

- 1) A flat, CNC-routed, low-polygon heart frame is cut from heavy-duty plywood and weatherized and/or painted.
- 2) The low-polygon frame is perforated with holes to fit zip ties.
- 3) Citizens zip tie objects they love and want to share with others to the Heart frames.
- 4) The objects are loved and wanted to share with others, or they can simply be objects citizens want to get rid of but would rather give to another home than be thrown out.
- 5) There are multiple Heart frames/sculptures placed all over the city.
- 6) The project is much like a “Mini Free Library” but for non-book objects.
