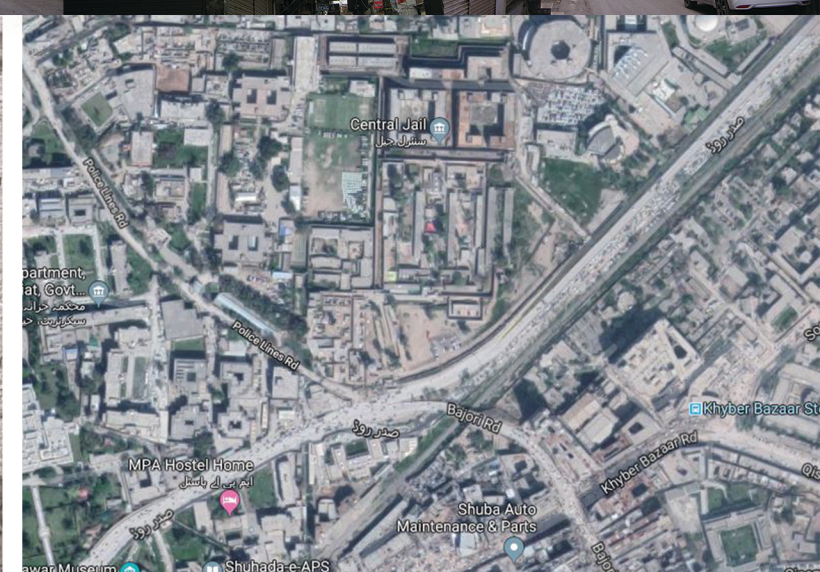
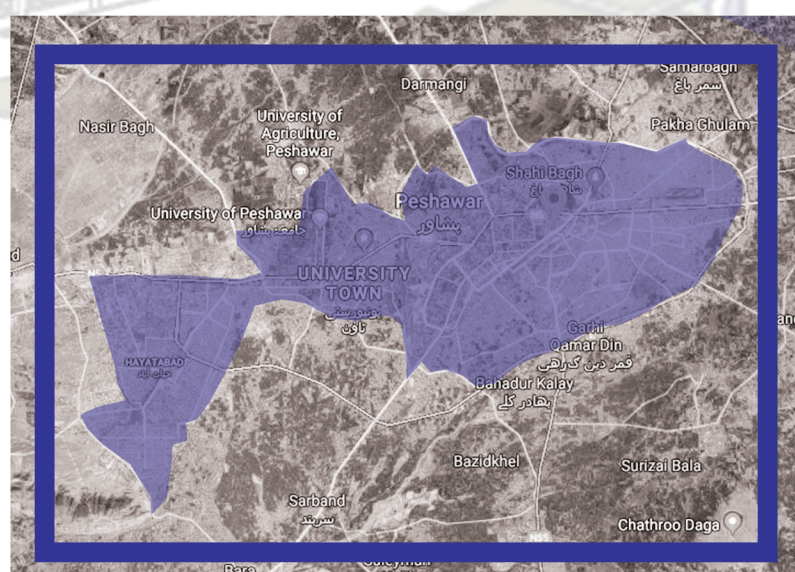
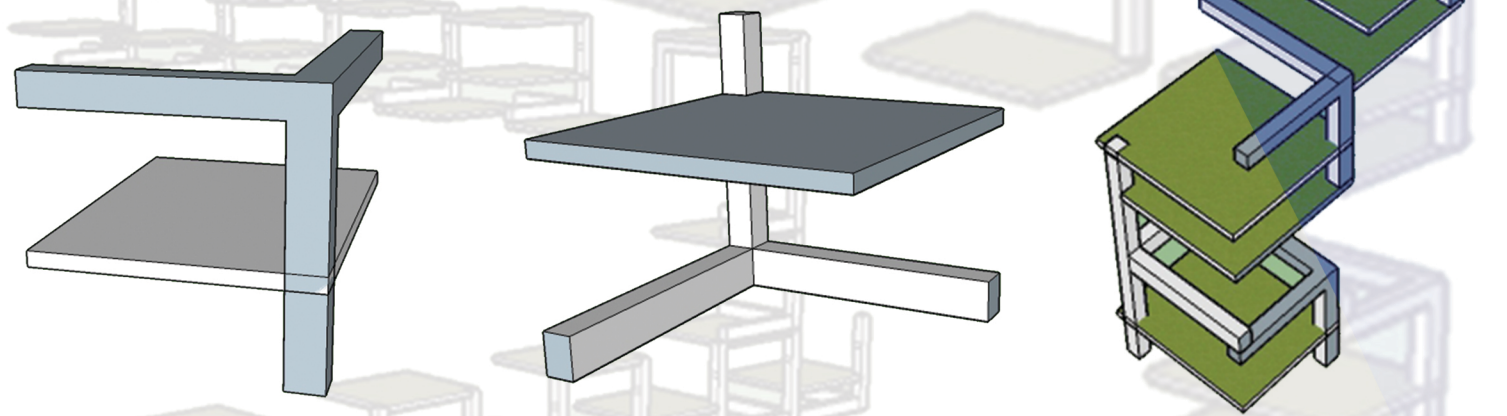


THE DIGITAL TREE

In a diverse, organic urban space like Saddar, Peshawar where land value is very high and construction is valued over green spaces, The Digital Tree is a 2'x2'x2' block of green space (grass, or shrub, or small tree) which can be attached to another block (like in Legos) to extend as far up or as far horizontally or diagonally as the user wants. The user decides how and where the green spaces travel, instantly. This also creates opportunity for:

1. bridges between buildings to utilize air space.
2. sitting spaces for the constantly moving people
3. robust green spaces.
