

What is dédédé?

dédédé is an online platform that invites people to share the various:

- Positive things and phenomena they find in cities ("Good"),
- Negative things and phenomena they find in cities ("Bad"),
- Curious, odd, or otherwise intriguing things and phenomena they find in cities ("Why")

We hope to realize a platform that can be used by a wide array of people, for both professional (e.g., research) and non-professional (e.g., journaling) purposes.




How to Use

On your PC or smartphone, open a browser of your choice (Chrome, Safari, etc.) and enter <https://dedede.de/en/> in the address bar.

dédédé is a web application, and does not require any additional apps to be installed on your device. It is also free to use!

IMPORTANT: Before using dédédé, please first read our terms of service at the following URL, and only use the site if you agree to the terms. Children under the age of 13 may not use dédédé.

Sign up, Log In, Log Out

Creating an account is not necessary if you only wish to browse d  d  d  .

However, many functions such as uploading posts are only available to registered users.

To create an account, please click **Sign Up** at the top right corner of the page, and enter your email address, desired username, and password.

To log in to the site, please click **Log In** and enter your email address and password.

To log out, click **Log Out**.


Browsing dédédé

The dédédé home page shows thumbnails of users' posts in a grid layout.

Please click on one of the posts — you will jump to a page that contains the post's details.

A post can contain the following information.

- Title
- Images
- Description
- Collections ("Good", "Bad", "Why", etc.)
- Tags ("Design / Art", "Culture / History", etc.)
- Audio
- Location



Browsing dédédé

By default, the home page shows all uploaded posts in chronological order.


Clicking on **Display Options** ▼ will open the control panel, where you can filter posts based on conditions such as upload date.

Clicking the bottom-left button  will open the map.

Posts are represented here using red markers .

Clicking on the map will place a pin  at that location.

You can use the pin to filter posts based on location, such as only showing posts within a 5km radius around the pin.



Posting a new dédédé

To post a new dédédé, please find and click this button  .

A submission form will appear, where you can enter the following information.

Title:

Please enter a title for your post.

The maximum length is 50 characters, but due to space limitations, long titles will only be partially visible on the home page.

Images (up to three):

As a general rule, we recommend that you only upload photos (in JPEG format) that you yourself have shot. Other types of images may be uploaded, but please be wary of copyright. Uploading AI-generated images is forbidden.

Posting a new dédédé

Description:

Please enter a description of your post (250 characters maximum).

You are free to create text-only posts, i.e., posts with descriptions but no images.

Collection:

Please add your post to any of three "collections" — Good, Bad, and Why — that reflect your intent behind the post. For example, posts that highlight positive aspects of cities are best added to "Good". You can also create new collections, as explained later.

Tag:

Please select tags that describe your post. You can also create new tags.

Posting a new dédédé

Audio (up to one minute):

A short audio clip can be recorded by clicking  .

Location:

If an attached image is geotagged (i.e., contains EXIF latitude/longitude data), location data will be loaded automatically. If you are not attaching geotagged images, or automatic loading fails for any reason, please set the location manually.

dédédé is a platform about public spaces — please only post about things and phenomena that you found in publicly-owned open spaces (such as parks and streets), or in private spaces that are nevertheless easily accessible by the general public (such as train stations).

Miscellaneous

Creating original collections:

First, open the menu by clicking on this button  at the top left corner of the screen.

From the menu, please visit "My Collections". Up to 9 original collections can be created.

Edit your profile:

From the menu, please visit "Profile".

To edit your avatar image, click  .

Edit account information:

From the menu, please visit "Account Info".

You can delete your account from this page as well. (Warning: deletions are final!)

Miscellaneous

Comments and reposts:

Comments can be added to posts. You can also "repost" other users' posts, attaching your own descriptions and adding them to your collection(s).

AI features:

We use AI to generate critiques for all posts, and to calculate similarities between posts. Both the critique and a list of similar posts can be found on the post's page.

Following and unfollowing users:

Clicking on a username anywhere on the site will take you to that user's page.

You can follow a user by clicking  here.

Checking Following Only on the home page will block out posts by users you are not following.
